A big warm welcome to Emu Explorers 2019!

We have had a busy, exciting and fun first few weeks in Emu Explorers. We have been focussing our time on getting to know each other, making new friends, and beginning to develop the routine of our room.

As part of our learning program we provide the children with long periods of uninterrupted play time for the children to follow their interests and ideas. Educators are always close by looking for opportunities to engage and find moments for intentional teaching. If you would like more information about our learning program it is on display next to the art centre and you are welcome to have a peruse.

In February we look forward to participating in planned activities such as cooking, science experiments, special sensory play and more. We will have these activities/events posted on the Family Communication Board above the sign in kiosk.

The children have been very engaged in our dramatic play centre which is currently a supermarket. The children have been exploring the roles of customers and cashiers and experimenting with the dialogue and conversations that fit in that setting.

Our investigation centre has been an area of quiet concentration as the children learn how to use a screw driver to work screws into a pre-drilled piece of wood. We have also been discussing the importance of using tools in a safe way, by sitting, wearing shoes and safety glasses.

We also have participated in 'Storytime in Space' where we tune into a space station and watch on as an astronaut reads a children's story. The last video we watched was about sunsets. We learnt that on the space station, they view 16 sunrises and sunsets every day. We then got to watch a sunset from the space station. It raised so many space questions from the inquisitive Emu Explorers minds.

Have you seen our Parent Pockets yet? These are located to the immediate right of our door. There is a pocket for each child, in alphabetical order. We will use these to send home communication from the room and other bits and pieces like party invitations.

I hope you have had the opportunity to meet the three staff members in the room: Beth, Shinae and Fiona- if not, please feel welcome to come over and say 'Hi!'

Some of the focus' we will work on in Kangaroo Kinders is school readiness which is seen through the children enhancing their self-help skills and independence, as well as learning about letter, number, shape and colour recognition. We also have started learning French which you'll notice throughout the year as the children use this language in their everyday practise. We will also be there to help your guide child to create meaningful relationships with other children to help enhance their social development and sense of identity.

The Kindergarten Program is run between the hours of 10:00am-3:00pm Monday-Friday. Each week we have a 'theme' or 'focus'. Our planner will be available near our program board, which will indicate the themes/focus for each week, with the corresponding activities. We will also provide copies starting term one for families to take home, so you can keep up with our progress throughout the term. We are extremely lucky to have an upstairs room available for us to use on a day to day basis, for our learning, play and development. This will mean smaller group sizes during the day which provide more one on one time with the children. Children participating in the Kindergarten Program here at Mitchell Street will also take part in four excursions during the year (usually one per term), as well as incursions.
